Steering Committee: Role

- Assist interface with Member States, in the area of FI
- Provide input for the ceFIMS work-plan;
- Recommend experts for nomination to Working Groups;
- Propose discussion topics at Future Internet Forum sessions, workshops & other meetings;
- Work with Executive Committee to define the scope of the road-mapping activity;





Steering Committee: Role

- Assist in the development of the roadmap reports:
 - Ensure outputs feed directly into Member State FI investment planning;
- Identify key dissemination activities for project results;
- Assist in identifying members of Judging Panel for Future Internet Award

Additional roles may be added as the work of the project progresses





Steering Committee: Membership

- Members drawn from Future Internet Forum;
- Committee of the Regions representative also invited;
 - Steering Committee will maintain close contact with the relevant Commission Services (incl. DG Regio, DG INFSO, DG Research);
- Membership rotates every six months;
- Meet at least once every semester; (plus 2 telecons.)





Steering Committee: Membership

- Current & incoming EU Council's Presidency represented;
- Chairperson of the Steering Committee will be current EU Council's Presidency host;
- ceFIMS coordinator & Leader of Work Package responsible for supporting Steering Committee (UMIC) join in an exofficio capacity

Working Groups: Role

- Discuss particular issues related to the development of the Future Internet;
- Support the development of the roadmap/implementation framework;
- Provide access to external expertise for the development of the ERA-NET+ roadmap.





Working Groups: Membership

- Members of Future Internet Forum & leading experts;
- Steering Committee will help select suitable experts:
 - Chosen on basis of established technical strengths & influence in industry or administrations
 - Multi-disciplinary coverage will also drive membership selection
- Membership will reflect need for bidirectional flow of information:
 - Dissemination of FP knowledge to Member States
 - Member States bringing forward information about Future Internet investments in their respective domains





Workshop

- First Working Group Workshop takes place at FIA Budapest, in May, 2011;
- Working Groups will address particular topics within the domain of European Future Internet, complimentary with:
 - 2020 Digital Agenda;
 - Innovation Union policies;
 - FP8 stakeholder consultation process.





Workshop: Topics

- Preliminary topics:
 - Cloud Computing
 - Trust & security
 - Internet-of-Things
 - Infrastructure of the Future Internet
 - Digital Government: pan-Europe e-ID, e-voting, mobility, etc.

These may evolve as ceFIMS progresses. A Chairperson will be selected for each Working Group & will oversee any shift in focus.

Future Internet Roadmapping

- Document detailing progress towards a common Future Internet Strategy & Vision;
- Foster stronger collaboration among Member States in Future Internet R&D;
- Engage with relevant parties & experts in Working Groups
 & Member State Authorities in the Future Internet Forum;
- Explore implementation through an ERA-NET+ and/or cooperation in Joint Programming.





Future Internet Roadmapping: Process

- ceFIMS will identify key actions to build consensus leading to the delivery of the roadmap. ceFIMS will:
 - Collect information on Member State Future Internet activities & initiatives (database);
 - Identify synergies & areas for more strategic cooperation between Member States & between Member States & the EU;
 - Document progress made towards realisation of synergies.
- These actions will feed into the discussions of the Working Groups & the development of the roadmap.





Research Roadmap: Interim versions

- V1: Sept. 2011 + V2: Sept. 2012
- Progress to-date towards FI ERA-NET+;
- Analyse barriers to achieving FI ERA-NET+;
- Evaluate ongoing development of PPP process;
- Assess PPP impacts on Member State initiatives & identify barriers to greater involvement by Member States in PPP;
- Identify measures for greater collaboration between PPP & FIF activities





Research Roadmap: Final version

- Due: Jan. 2013
- Clear plan for achieving FI ERA-NET+ and Joint Programming harmonisation
- Maximum alignment with Member State initiatives,
 FP7/FP8 and PPP deployment project results;
- Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) also prepared:
 - Multilateral agreement between committed Member States for the creation of an ERA-NET+
 - Presented to EC at the end of the project as one of the final deliverables (Interim version available in Sept. 2012)





Roadmap: Impact

- Clearly defined set of objectives & priorities
 - Decrease fragmentation & support synergies of Member States' investment;
- Engagement of key stakeholders (government decisionsmakers and the Member States funding agencies) will ensure coordination of Regional & National funding;
- Inform PPP & FP8 planning process of priority areas;
- MoU intends to devolve practical application of FI research to new PPP
